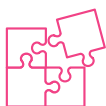


Our Mission, Vision, & Values

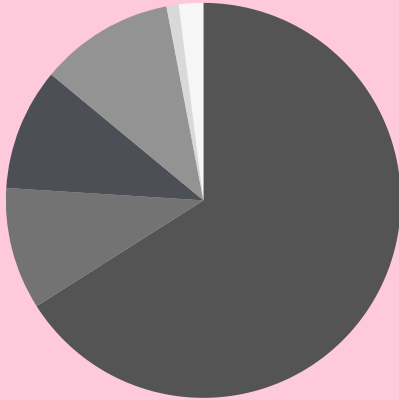

2025 DEMOGRAPHICS: BRIDGING

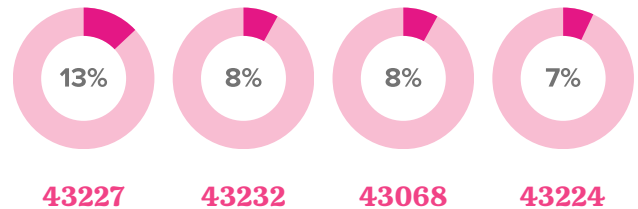

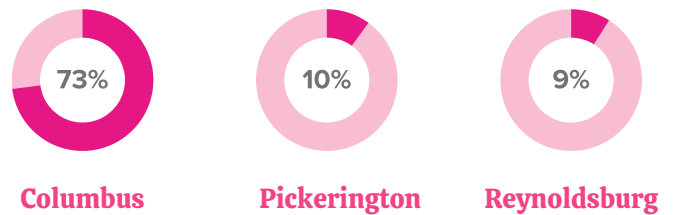

GEOGRAPHY

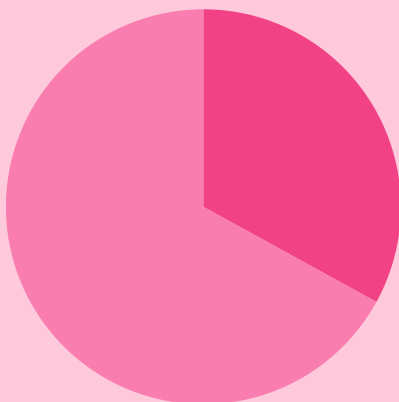
TOP ZIP CODES

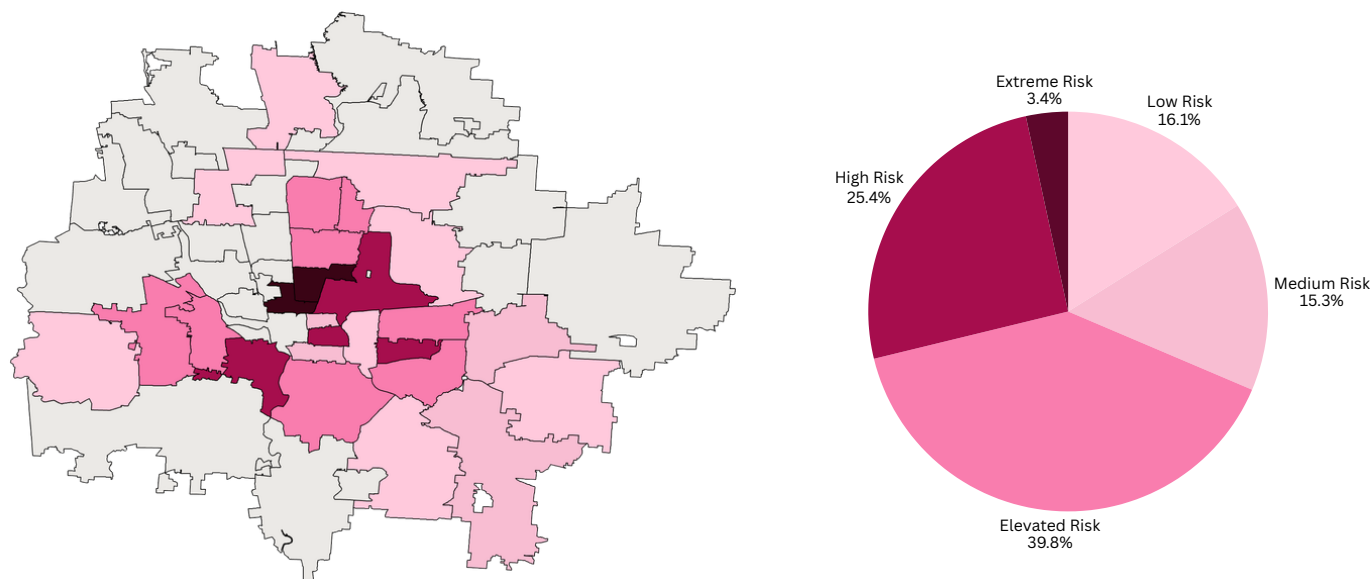

EQUITY GAPS IN CENTRAL OHIO



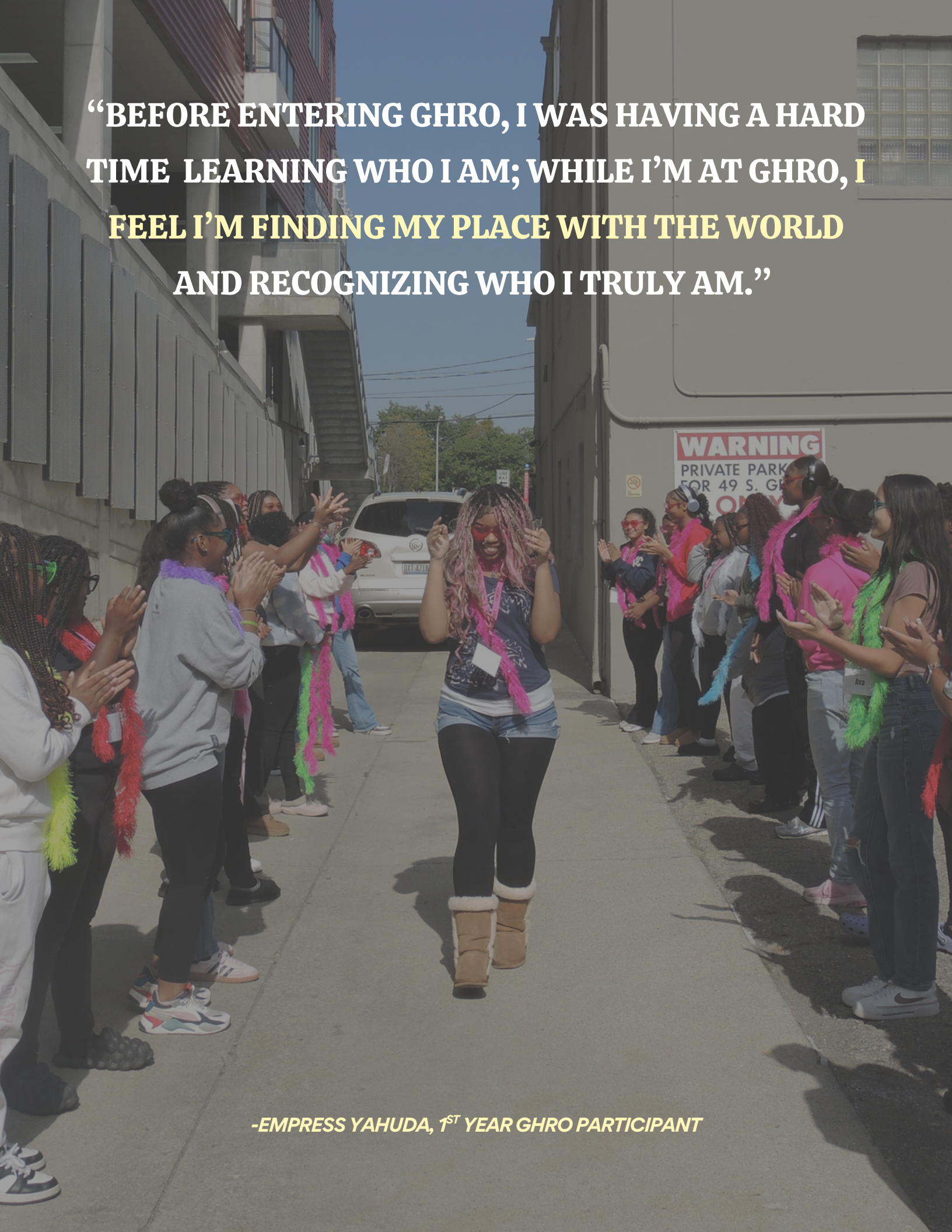
Femergy provides services in Franklin County and the Columbus Metropolitan Area, targeting those at risk through **strategic recruitment**; a consistent **presence in the community** at resource fairs, local schools, and community-wide events; and **accessible hours and support resources** at the Femergy Center. We prioritize building relationships with the families we serve, and in communities that face greater risk factors.

In Franklin County, 60% of evictions occur in just 8 zip codes. **53.4% of Femergy participants resided in these zip codes in 2025.**

Across the county and Columbus, we see concentrated areas of need with elevated levels of poverty. In 2025, **83.9% of Femergy participants would be considered at-risk** due to where they live.

Tackling these barriers takes a village. In 2025, all of our programs rapidly expanded to increase capacity and services, providing **transportation, program meals, and other supportive services** to participants at higher rates than ever before. We work alongside direct services organizations in our community to make this possible, and will continue to expand our capacity and partnerships to ensure every girl, woman, and family has the access and support they need to thrive.

GHRO YOUR FUTURE

In 2025, GHRO Your Future soared to new heights with expanded program models, community presence, and youth leadership! GHRO Your Future is designed to create multiple access points for girls to receive academic, social, and leadership support. By providing **flexible programming both inside and outside of school** hours, we meet students where they are and ensure no girl is left behind.

OUR MODELS

SCHOOL-BASED LUNCH & LEARNS

In 2025, GHRO programming was provided to **5 schools!** These workshops allow us to address the immediate needs and interests of each school's unique student population, which creating a safe space for discussion, confidence-building, and peer connection.

COMMUNITY MENTOR MATCHING

Mentor-matching is available for any girl in the community. These one-on-one mentoring relationships provide positive role models, help guide girls through barriers, encourage girls to pursue their personal goals, and expose them to opportunities that build leadership and career readiness.

AFTERSCHOOL WEDNESDAYS

Afterschool Wednesdays invites girls to the Femergy® Center every week for dedicated **tutoring, study sessions, mentorship, and personal development.** These weekly sessions provide stability, routine, and encouragement for students as they excel academically and support each other's personal goals. Students also have access to our **hygiene closet** and other tangible resources to support their overall wellness and intellectual development.

Our signature community cohort continued to thrive in 2025! We closed out the 2024-2025 cycle in May with our **cohort of 31 girls**, who participated in 17 workshops throughout the cycle. Our three-phase approach strengthens participants' social-emotional development; matches them with community mentors to bridge opportunity gaps; and builds workforce readiness and leadership skills that prepare them to step confidently into roles that drive long-term economic mobility. Through eight months of programming, our cohort has developed the resilience and self-confidence to engage in their communities as emerging leaders, modeling empowerment, persistence, and service!

"Since the beginning of GHRO, I have seen a major change in social interactions and my personal outlook. When I first entered this program, I was a person defined largely by the boundaries of my own hesitations. Engaging in group work or leading a discussion felt like an insane reach but GHRO's team-building and confidence activities forced me to confront my fears and **I learned that my voice had value** and that the "judgment" I feared from others was just a projection of my own self-criticism. I became more of a leader and more confident in my choices as an individual, which also helped me with my self confidence and trust within. This program has honestly made me believe in myself in all aspects and become more of a curious and empathetic leader, providing me with all the tools and techniques to accomplish my future goals."

"Before GHRO, the idea of college or career training felt overwhelming. I did not fully understand the steps involved or what options were available to me. Through lessons and discussions, I learned how to understand requirements, and explore different paths such as college and trade programs. This helped me feel more informed and less stressed about my future. My mentor, Andrea, played a huge role in my growth throughout the program. She helped guide me toward pursuing a trade in a dental hygiene program, which is something I am now seriously interested in. Andrea also stayed on me about my grades and encouraged me to stay focused in school. **Knowing that someone believed in me and cared about my success motivated me to take my academics more seriously.** Her support helped me see that my goals are achievable if I stay disciplined and committed."

FEMERGY® CHICA SUMMER EXPERIENCE

In 2025, we hosted our biggest Femergy Chica Camp yet, with an **extra day of camp** and **eight additional spots** available! That wasn't all - Femergy Chica Camp has evolved into the Femergy Chica Summer Experience, with **drop-in hours** at the Femergy Center, **mini-clinics**, and opportunities to engage with the community all summer long!

MINI-CLINICS, DROP-IN HOURS & COMMUNITY SERVICES

The Femergy Center was open all summer for drop-in hours! Students stopped by to work on applications for jobs, scholarships, and leadership opportunities; accessed safe-spaces designed for them, like our **Zen room**; were connected with tangible supportive materials from our **hygiene closet**; and worked with Femergy staff and **mentors** to develop their personal wellness and leadership skills!

Our Chica Chat mini-clinic, hosted in partnership with **Bridgn Gaps, LLC**, focused on developing students' communication and collaboration by explore communication styles (verbal, non-verbal, written), what defines healthy and effective communication, and how they can practice active listening, clarity, empathy, and feedback!

We brought resources to the community at the **Columbus Women & Girls' Festival**, including sports bras, leggings, personalized wellness keychains for long-term development!



FEMERGY CHICA CAMP

In 2025 we returned to Deer Creek State Park for an extended camp week! Our capacity increased from **20 to 28 students**, and our camp schedule expanded to include an extra day for a total of **five days and four nights** of growth, development, and wellness programming. Activities included kayaking, yoga, field day, art therapy workshops, an environmental service project, journaling sessions, and more!

Our waitlist for camp includes over 50 families every year. The expansions we made in 2025 wouldn't be possible without support from our community partners and individuals who invest in the Femergy Chica Summer Experience, and allow us to provide a week-long immersive development program at no cost to these families. FEMERGY COLLECTIVE

In 2025, Femergy Collective blossomed with a new **Think Tank series** that emphasized **collective impact**, **community-building**, and **holistic support**. From these sessions, participants walked away with new relationships, resources, and strategies to develop professionally without sacrificing their personal goals and wellness. The series included:

SHAPING THE FUTURE OF WOMEN

Our first Think Tank brought women-serving organizations and leaders from Columbus together to discuss gaps in the landscape and share strategies, resources, and upcoming opportunities for collaboration.

SPEAK UP, STAND FIRM

Hosted in partnership with **Meganne Thaxton**, participants from public and private sectors shared their experiences climbing the leadership ladder, and explored the power of negotiation in life and business.

BREAKING FREE FROM BURNOUT

Hosted in partnership with **Charlene Free**, participants developed personal wellness practices and professional development strategies as we explored the hidden impacts of burnout on our health, relationships, and productivity.

In the fall, our signature **EmpowHER Mixer** created opportunities for personal and professional connection with a fun, floral twist! In partnership with **Oh My! Events**, participants built custom bouquets while networking with other women, leaders, and allies in Central Ohio!
